Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> September

Boats that are not local to the Orwell estuary may wish travel on the Sunday and book a berth at either Shotley or Levington to enable an easy start to the cruise the following day. I am happy to help with berth booking for Levington (SYH) or Shotley

High tide Harwich: 12.55 (4.08m)





Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September

Assemble at Shotley around 9.00am and sail to Titchmarsh Marina, mooring at reserved berth. Evening SAD's and nibbles at the BBQ area.

High tide Harwich: 13.28 (4.07m)







Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> September

Relax day in Walton-on Naze including group 'stroll' to Frinton-on-Sea and a 'Cake and a cuppa' (or something a just little stronger!). Evening BBQ and drinks.

High tide Harwich: 13.59 (4.00m)







Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> September

Leave berths at your leisure and sail to the River Orwell, berthing at Shotley Marina. BBQ and music in the evening.

High tide Harwich: 14.33 (3.92m)







Thursday 21st September

Leave Shotley mid/late morning and enjoy a picturesque sail up the River Stour, making most of the flood tide en-route. Option to anchor at Erwaton for lunch (between ruined jetty and South Cardinal) and leave just before High tide to take the ebb back to Shotley, then on to RHYC. Fun 'race' with self-timed journey from Erwaton South Cardinal to No.5 buoy off Pinmill. Cruise dinner in the evening with pre-drinks @ 7.00pm

High tide Harwich: 15.09 (3.82m)





Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September

Leave RHYC for Ipswich Marina. Tour of Spirit Yachts is arranged for 2.00pm – numbers are limited so booking ASAP please?

High tide Harwich: 15.52 (3.67m)
